Assignment:

Participate in <u>one public tour</u> and <u>one Art Cart</u> and reflect upon the experiences as you complete an observation worksheet for each one.

Due date:

Turn in your completed observation worksheets no later than **March 15**.

Guidelines:

- You may observe tours and Art Carts on <u>any</u> topic, time period, theme, etc.
- Try to observe one tour or Art Cart led by your mentor and one led by another docent or CIF guide, so you can see more than one style/approach to interacting with visitors.
- Choose <u>public tours</u> and/or <u>Art Carts</u> on weekdays, Sundays, or Thursday evenings or Saturdays when we don't have class. <u>Do not</u> make plans to observe tours/carts during our scheduled training times.

- As a courtesy to your guide peers, contact the Docent or CIF guide leading the tour <u>at least</u> 24 hours in advance to let them know you'll be joining their tour or Art Cart. - If you want to attend the tour or Art Cart of a specific individual (e.g. your mentor), you may find it easiest to contact them now and ask them when they're scheduled to volunteer in January, February and March.

Reminders:

- You are not evaluating the performance of the individual docent or guide whose tour or Art Cart you observe.
- You are instead reflecting upon the overall *experience* (of the guide, of museum visitors) and thinking about how you will apply the things you learned to your own future practice as a guide.
