
To log in, use your first initial and last name, no spaces or punctuation. The password is mia4all.



*Include the name of the website/web page that was referenced, rather than just including a general url.






Blank Object File form is posted in Word and Pages format. If you use Pages, you MUST re-save as a Word file before submitting the object file to IPE staff.
