# EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

Notify Security Control at

EXT. 5555\*

### **MEDICAL EMERGENCY**

- Call 911 and notify Security Control at Ext. 5555\*.
- Security personnel are trained and will administer first aid.
- Do not move the person unless he or she is in danger.
- Avoid leaving the person except to call for help.

### **FIRE**

- Activate fire alarm and notify Security Control at Ext, 5555\*.
- Extinguish fire if safe to do so, and you are trained to operate the extinguisher.
- If unable to extinguish, evacuate according to procedures below. Alert others as you exit.
- Close doors behind you to confine the fire, and move a safe distance away from building.
- Do NOT use elevators.

# **BUILDING EVACUATION**

- Listen carefully for instructions via the PA system.
- Shut down any hazardous operations, and leave quickly.
- Encourage others to leave while exiting.
- Please take responsibility for your guest(s).

### **BUILDING LOCKDOWN**

- Listen carefully for instructions via the PA system.
- Remain within the designated safe area until the "all clear" message has been given



## **SEVERE WEATHER**

- Listen carefully for instructions via the PA system.
- Follow Security's directions to safe areas.
   Do not leave safe areas until instructed by Security.
- Do NOT use elevators.
- Stay away from exterior walls and glass.
   Crouch along interior walls and cover your head.

# **PERSONAL THREAT**

- If you are threatened, or if you witness a
  personal threat, notify Security Control at
  Ext. 5555\*, or contact the nearest security
  representative.
- If near a fire alarm, pull to activate alarm.
- Attempt to put distance between you and the person threatening you.

## **SUSPICIOUS PERSON**

- Do NOT confront the person.
- Discreetly notify Security Control at Ext. 5555\*.

### SUSPICIOUS PACKAGE

- Do NOT touch or move package.
- Leave the immediate area and notify
   Security Control at Ext. 5555\*.
