- 5. Arrive at the Third Avenue entrance, and have students wait on the bus while one contact from the school checks in with the school tour coordinator inside the Third Avenue doors. (Note for homeschool groups: communicate that parents separately arriving with students should check in with the school tour coordinator in the Third Avenue entrance.)

- 6. Refer to the Mia Tour Guidelines, included in your tour confirmation, and let me know of any questions you have regarding the additional guidelines.
