

2. 養鳥， 鳥籠

Bird Cage and accessories: feeder, water, bird poop remover, bowl, Seed Catcher, swing , bird bath, cage cover

Swing, Mirror, Perches, Waterer

Perches give birds more places to stand.

Swing lets birds swing back and forth.

mirror lets pet bird gaze at itself in the mirror.

the bird waterer provides a constant supply of water to your birds.

Raising birds as pet has been a long history in China. Each dynasty had its own favorite birds to have. But the hobby of walking pet birds became popular since the Qing Dynasty (1644-1911) and this tradition continues with many people still taking pleasure from this simple outdoor activity.

In China, we see men, young and old (but mostly old) walk their pet birds in the early morning. While walking their birds, a bird's owner will swing the cage back and forth gently, forcing the bird to get a bit of exercise as it clings to its perch.

Once in the park, the birdcages are hung near each other on the tree, giving the birds a chance to socialize while their owners do the same. A bird that isn't taken out, bird owners say, will become depressed; it will not sing and will lose its feathers.

Their birds hop and chirp inside their cages. Sitting below, their owners spark up conversation with friends, perform tai chi, play cards or take on a friend in Chinese chess.

This is a typical scene not only in Beijing but also in other cities across the nation.
