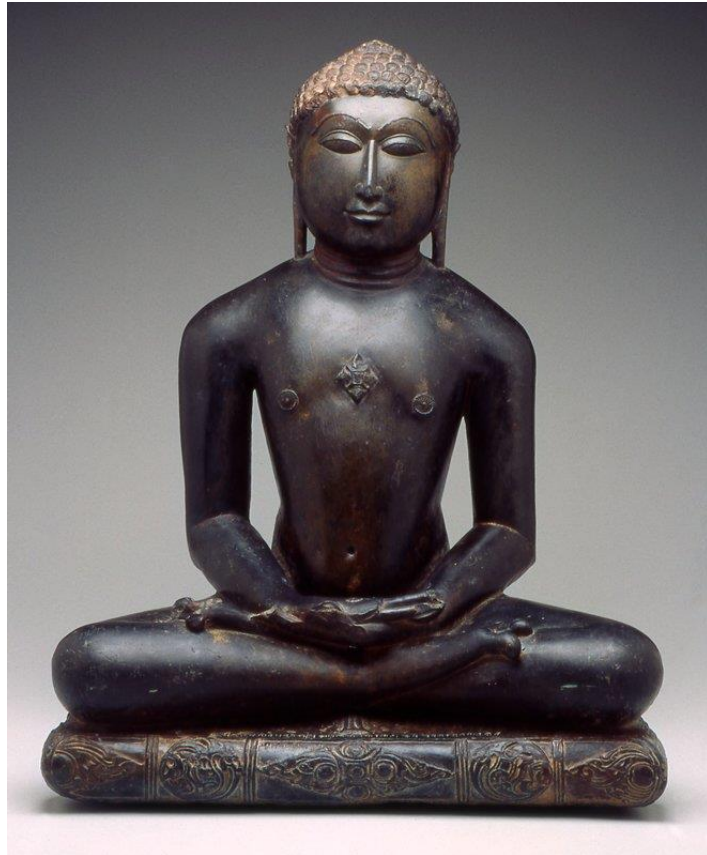

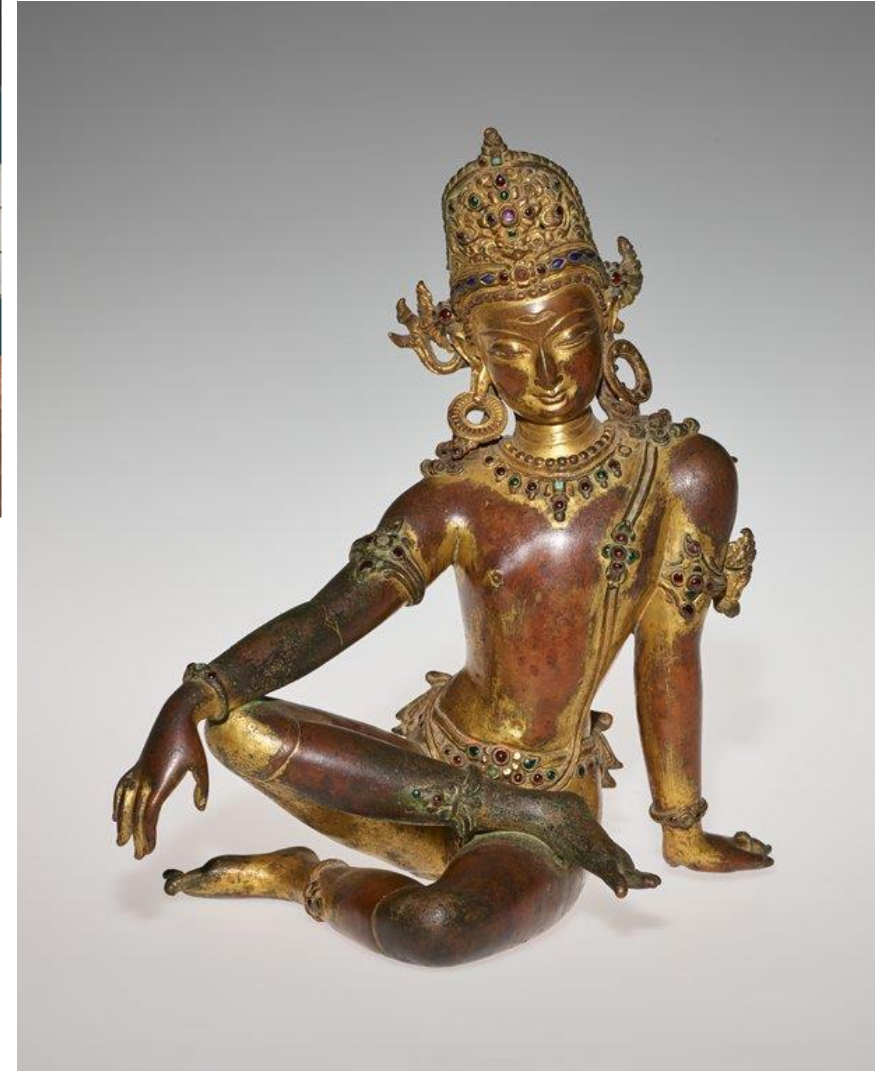

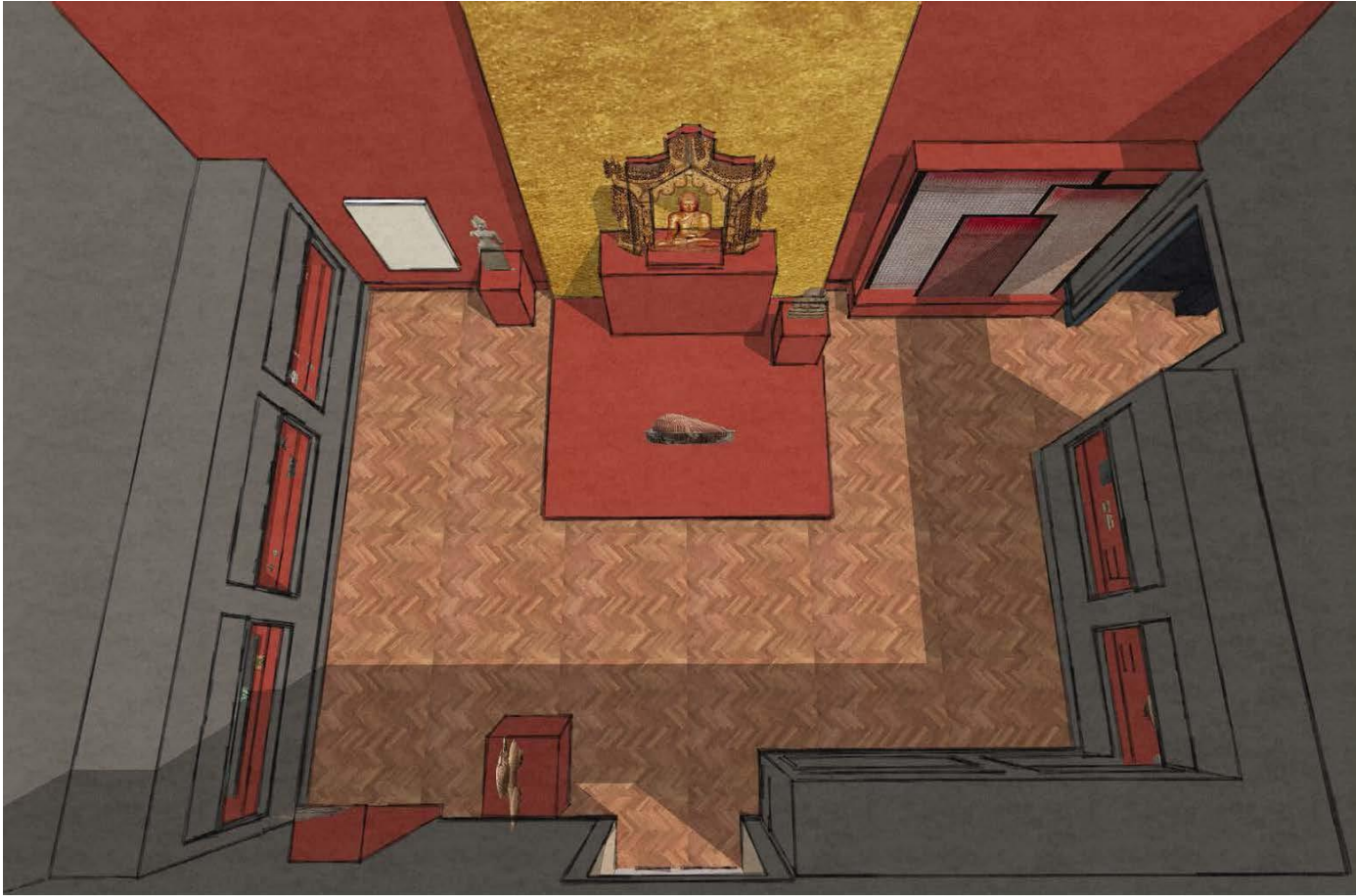


Indra, Nepal, 13-14th C



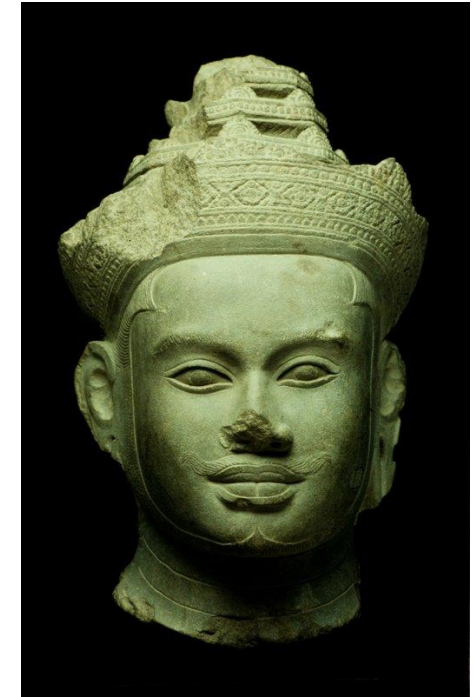
