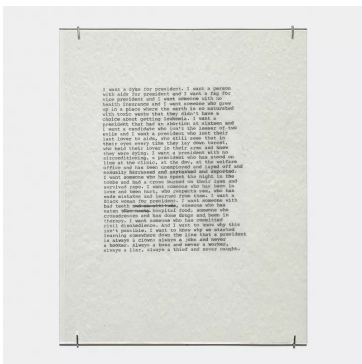

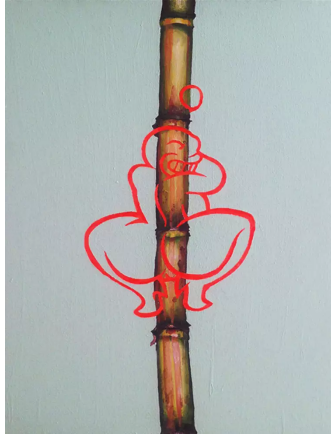

- G322 will have a work by Hartley from the Kunin collection, a painting of a banana by John Wilde that was owned by (and commented on) by his friend Dudley Huppler, who was queer, and that will be noted on the label.
- G323 will have a painting by Marsden Hartley from the Kunin collection on view; there are several portraits being changed in there, including a Mersky promised gift of a self-portrait as Athena by Marcia Marcus -- it's a great example of persona playing and costuming; a nude self portrait by Anne Abrons, and hopefully Emma Amos's Tightrope -- a self portrait. while these are not "queer" they are explicitly about empowerment and self-definition, also play.
- G360 will have works by Pavel Tchelitchew, Bernard Perlin, and Marsden Hartley from the Kunin collection; the Perlin is a portrait of his then lover, a designer named Robert Drew.
- G361 will have works by Paul Cadmus, Beauford Delaney, two by George Tooker from the Kunin collection

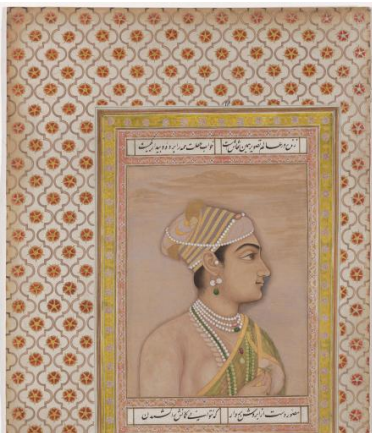
